Your application will be given to local media who will be announcing parade units during the parade. It is to your advantage to be as informative as possible. Please write legibly and make sure information is complete. Please provide an email address and phone number with the area code so we may contact you if we have questions regarding your application. Applications must be approved by the Superintendent of the Michigan City Park Department.

RULES: All drivers must have a valid driver's license. Nothing may be thrown or squirted along the parade route, you may hand items to spectators. No unsafe actions are allowed. All units must continue in a forward motion. If walkers, or your unit stop and delay the parade, you will be asked to exit the parade at the nearest side street.
